Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Approval for Middle Class Syllabus as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The school has applied for “Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level”. Further, school has constructed ground floor + basement only and all of the labs and library are set-up in the basement, which does not appear safe for students. Hence, the school is granted upto middle class syllabus with restriction to 08 sections. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per bylaws subject to availability of classrooms of greater than 500 ft dimension.
2	The school is directed not to use the basement for academic purposes involving students and shift all of the labs and library to ground level within 03 months as per Board’s SoP for labs and library and submit the compliance.
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Further , there are paper signage placed at the entrance of the CwSN toilets. Thus, the school is required to re-construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board’s guidelines within 3 months and submit the compliance
4	The ramp constructed to access the toilets is steep, narrow and without railing. Apparently , it cannot be used by the CwSN students to access the toilet conveniently. Thus, the school is required to pull-it down and re-construct the ramp as per norms of RPwD Act and board’s guidelines, within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	Library is seen as under stocked. The school needs to add more books of different genres,

	besides reference books, journals, magazines and newspapers. The Library do not have a separate reading area for the staff of the School. Further the Library is located in the basement therefore the same needs to be re-located to the ground level . The school shall upgrade and re-locate the Library in light of the SOP issued by the board and submit compliance within 3 months on SARAS with videography.
6	(i)The Composite lab is under stocked and the demonstration tables are set-up on makeshift temporary tables. (ii)There is inadequate seating arrangement. (iii) The Lab does not have proper storage facility for all chemicals and equipment. (iv)The Lab is located in the basement of the school which is not acceptable from the safety point of view. The School is required to upgrade the Composite science Lab as per SoPs for composite Science Lab issued by the Board and shift it to ground floor level within 3 months and submit compliance in the SARAS portal..
7	At the entrance of the school boards, with school's name "Group of schools & colleges" is also mentioned. Thus, the school is directed to remove the same within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Prayagraj within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye - Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
